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Course Objectives

All class communication is conducted completely in the target language

- Quizzes and final examinations reflect this methodology
- Final examination is 1/2 oral, 1/2 written
- Students can create podcasts (video or audio) as part of the oral examination.
- Assessment of language proficiency
- Podcasts support these objectives

Podcast production consists of:

- Instructor-created podcasts
- Students-created podcasts



Students Outcomes

Student become active participants in the learning process.

- Production of spontaneous speech
- Podcasts fosters learners' autonomy
- Collaborative production of podcasts strengthens student motivation and competency.
- Students will be able to use podcasts for their academic and professional endeavors outside of the scope of the language classroom.



Logistic and Technical Features

- Production of podcasts: Audacity, Windows Movie Maker, iMovie, Premiere Elements, MP3 Players, Digital Camera, file converters, etc.
- Students are offered training and a space where they can produce audio and video podcasts.
